What does a Direct Care Worker do?

Personal Care - showering, hygiene and grooming.

Domestic Assistance - basic housework, washing and ironing, meal preparation.

Social Support - outings and social activities, shopping, transport to appointments.

Respite Care Medication Administration Provide assistance and companionship

- You will perform a range of tasks aligned with the needs of the Client and as detailed in a provided Care Plan.
- > You will drive from client to client, so you are required to hold a full driver's licence and an insured vehicle.
- Generally shifts can be between 7am through to 10pm with some weekend work if you are available.

What are the mandatory requirements of this role?

- Certificate III in Individual Support, or
- Certificate III Disability Support, or
- Certificate III Community Services, or equivalent.
